SITE MANAGER

He/she will be responsible for the detailed planning of activities and the development of the installation and commissioning phases, supervising the team and coordinating the staff involved.

ABOUT THE ROLE

He/she will be responsible for resolving any issues that may arise during the execution of activities and will conduct regular meetings to ensure alignment with expectations with both the team and customers. Daily reporting on the progress of activities, agreed definitions and any issues will be an integral part of the role, in order to monitor the progress of installation and commissioning activities. Finally, he/she will draft closure reports for assigned jobs or phases, documenting results and solutions adopted to improve effectiveness and efficiency in future experiences.

The main activities will be the following:

- Managing one or more projects, ensuring that they are processed correctly, according to the defined contractual conditions and the instructions received from the Project Manager.
- Planning in detail the activities and defining the development plan for the installation and commissioning/launch phases, deploying the team entrusted to him/her by the Project Manager or requesting an appropriate structure in realisation of the assigned task and coordinating the assigned human resources.
- Developing and sustaining over time relationships with customers and suppliers involved in the project, both in order to create new business opportunities and to project a positive company image. Maintain relationships also within the organisation, pulling the strings and mediating between the parties.

- Drawing up daily reports on the progress of activities, agreed definitions, problems, etc., aimed at recording the progress of installation and commissioning activities.
- Complying and enforcing safety, quality, and environmental
